

## KUKA Roboter at the open days of HTL Paul-Hahn-Straße - Linzer Technikum

On January 13<sup>th</sup> and 14<sup>th</sup> 2017 the technical school HTL Paul-Hahn-Straße – Linzer Technikum (shortly LiTec) held its annual open days. Highly-motivated students and teachers welcomed over 700 guests and answered all possible questions during a guided tour through the school.

An extraordinary highlight of that tour was the robot lab with creative applications, all programmed on KUKA robots by the students themselves. One robot, for example, mixed non-alcoholic drinks for the visitors whereas they could play some kind of table tennis game on another robot.
